



- Sixty seven percent of Indian households do not treat their drinking water, even though it could be chemically or bacterially contaminated.





HOME LESSNESS IN INDIA

- More than 100 million people are homeless worldwide, and 78 million are found in India.
- 63% of the homeless people are slum dwellers.
- 40% of the homeless are from urban areas.
- 11 million children are living on the streets.
- 68.7% people earn less than Rs. 100 a day.

People living, eating and sleeping on the streets is a regular site in india. Millions of poor who can not afford to buy a roof over their head end upon the foot paths and flyovers of flourishing metros of India. They are elderly people, physically and mentally challenged, flood and drought victims even women, children and unemployed youths embrace the foot path as shelter.

Life on the streets is fraught with many dangers Horror stories ranging from acid attacks, sexual abuse, police and go on atrocities to regular fights for two square meals. 

The pathetic conditions of Muslim community are statistically proved and put on record by Justice Sachar Committee Report. Muslims are lagging behind in most of the fields. The worst is the representation of Muslims in the higher echelons of Administration particularly

Bureaucracy, Police Administration, Judiciary, & Armed Forces.

The representation of Muslims in higher Civil Services over they ears after independence has reduced to the lowest, compared with their population percentage of about 18%. The statistics reveal that it is hardly 2 to 3.5%.

There are many NGOs who are making sincere efforts to prepare eligibly ouths for the Civil Services Exams. Human Welfare Trust's decision to provide Grants to 10 IAS aspirants each year is just an addition to the efforts made by the community at various levels.

High dropout rates among Muslim students are worrisome. As many as 25 per cent of Muslim children in the 6-14 year age group have either never attended school or have dropped out. The main reason for educational back wardness of Muslims is abject poverty due to which children are forced to drop out after the first few classes.

Poor and illiterate parents can not afford tuition for their children; nor can they provide the necessary support system at home which has become so essential a part of today's educational system. The opportunity costs involved in sending children to school is also too high, making it difficult for parents to do so.

Mere financial aid for education will not solve the problem. The students and their parents need to be motivated in order to keep them moving up the ladder of Education.

"Inadequate budget allocation, dismal school infrastructure in rural areas, high dropout rates, are the hallmarks of our education system". Even the minimal infrastructure, such as proper rooms, desks, drinking water facility, toilets, is missing in a large number of schools.

A large number of schools are

being run across the country by s o c i a l l y c o n c e r n e d people/organizations with little or no resources. In most of the cases they are even short of necessary infrastructure. These schools, having good potential for the up liftment of the society, need some intervention to develop their basic infrastructure so as to improve the educational status of the community.


Our School's Capacity Building



orning Schools, makeshift in nature, are usually established in a Mosque or a Community Hall or any such place. These schools offer hope to poor children in the neighbourhood.

The objective of establishing morning schools ranges form imparting basic minimum education to the children (some adults also) in the locality who cannot afford the luxury of attending a formal school to teaching Quran and basic Islamic knowledge to the children who are already enrolled in formal schools.

Morning Schools offer free education to the children of

the local labourers and farmers. Being poor and mostly illiterate, the families of these children usually either see no need for them to be educated, or worry about the costs involved, particularly when sending them to school means they cannot help to support the family.



- To promote awareness for the authentic Islamic way of life.



ore than 8 million children aged 6-13 in India are out of school, either never having attended or dropping out before completing 6th grade. The situation in slums is far more worrying.

The slums of India, are a breeding ground for poverty, exploitation, negligence, destitution and disease. Children living in these slums have poor access to schools; there is a high dropout rate from school by grade 6, often because slum children are employed in the labour sector at a young age. Many of them, seeking to supplement the family income, work in distant locations which make regular

attendance at school impossible.

For many thousands of children growing up in India's slums, just getting a foothold on the bottom rung of the educational ladder is difficult. But with that vitalfirst step into learning and a lot of hard work, slum children can hope to realise their dream of a better life in India's rapidly changing society.

Under the **Slum School Project** we establish small one teacher schools in slum areas with minimal infrastructure to facilitate easy access to quality education for the children living there. This project is helping thousands of children onto the learning ladder.


