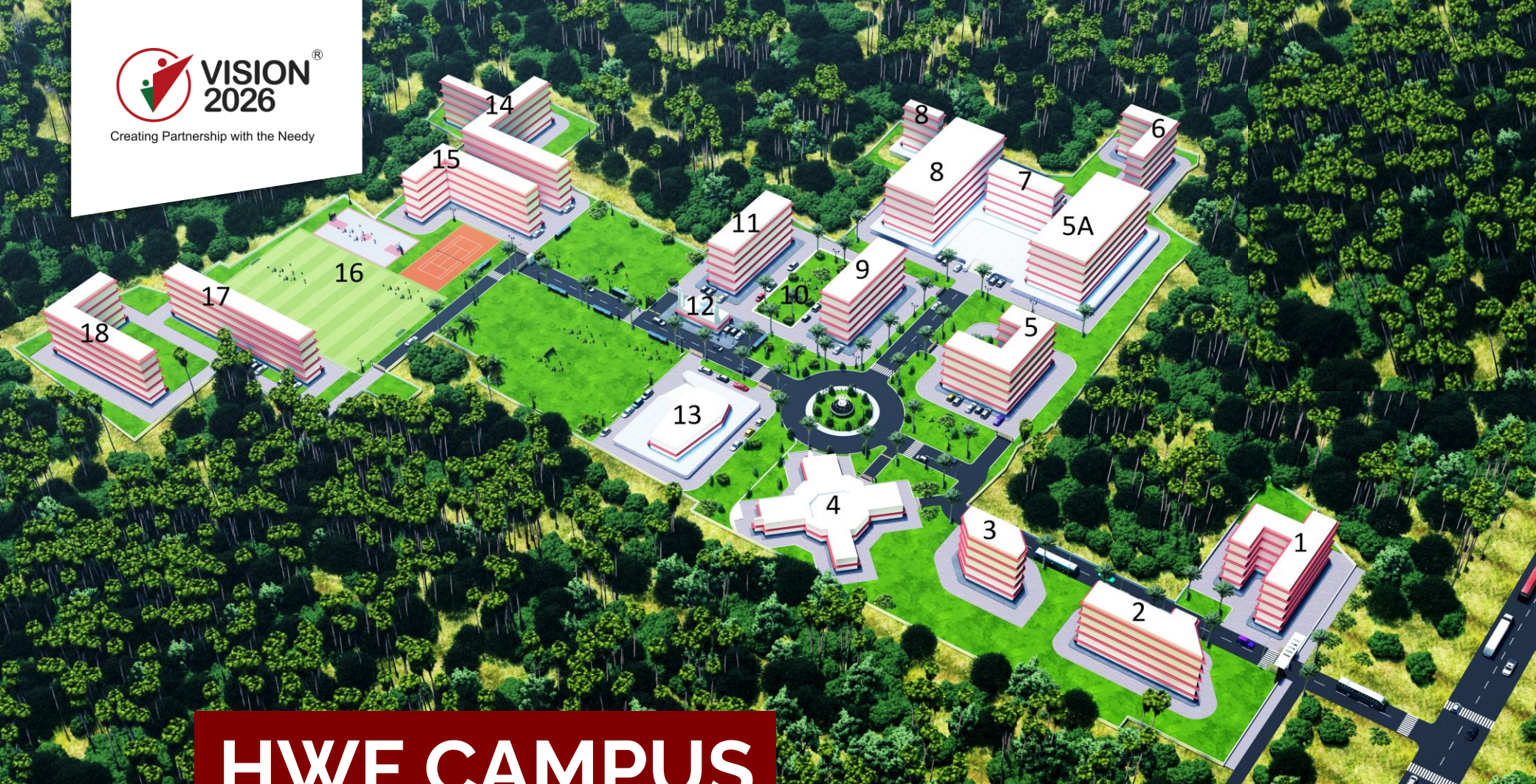

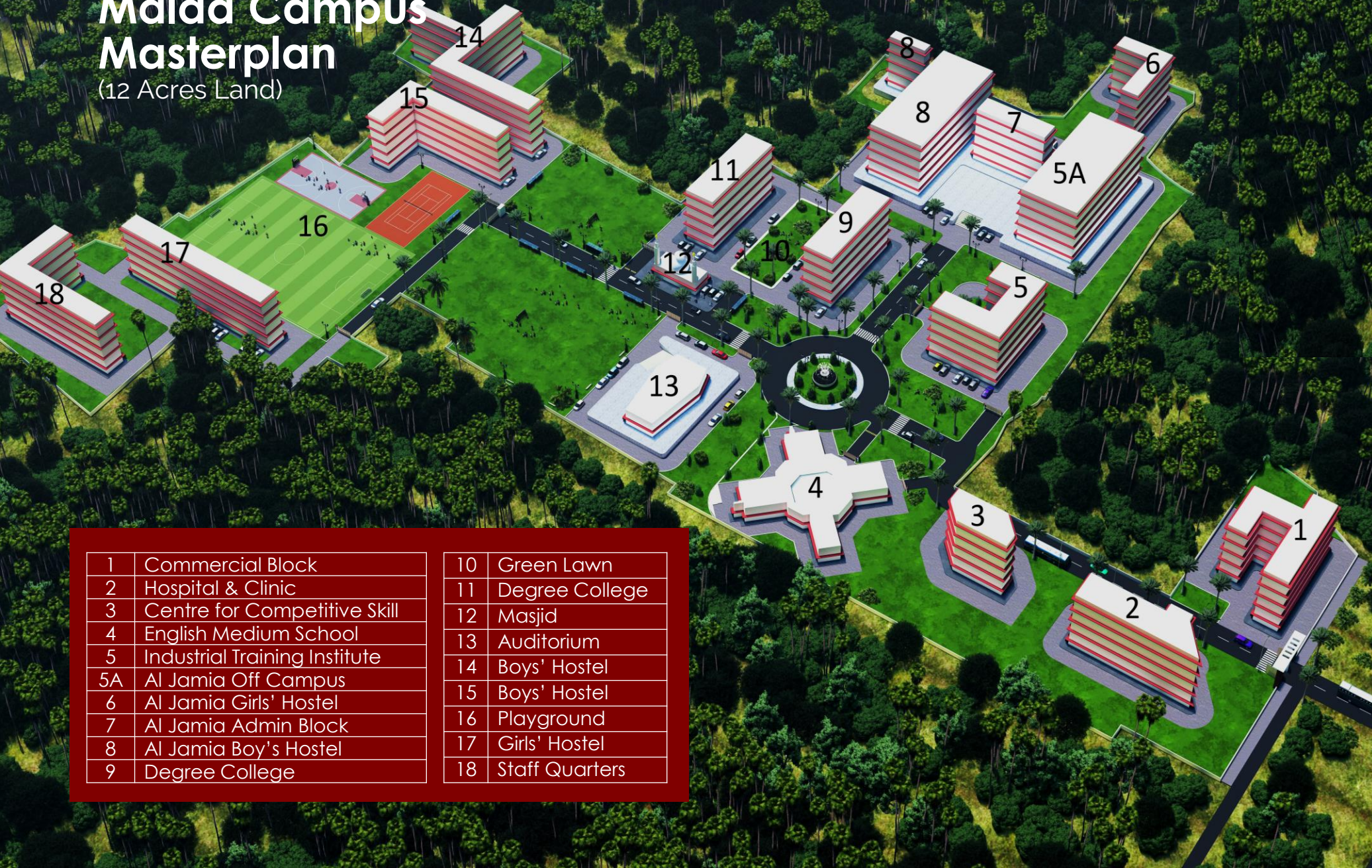

## Among the literate Muslims in W. Bengal, only 2.7% hold a graduate degree

A 2016 study 'Living Reality of Muslims in West Bengal' by Professor Amartya Sen's Pratichi Institute in collaboration with non-profit organisations SNAP and Guidance Guild, exposed the living realities and socio-economic conditions of Muslims in West Bengal. The report shows that among the literate Muslims, only 2.7% holds graduate degree or above and about 15% Muslim children aged 6-14 years are found to be out of school while 9.1% were never enrolled. A large portion of the community members, the study notes, either remain "illiterate" or, at best, earn the "school dropout" tag.

The distribution of primary schools in districts is not equitable, the study finds. District-wise distribution shows that Bengal has an average of 8.48 primary government schools per 10,000 people. However, nine districts recorded a lower ratio than the state's average – Kolkata, North 24 Parganas, Howrah, Hooghly, South 24 Parganas, Nadia, Bardhaman, Malda and Murshidabad. Of these, three districts — Murshidabad, Malda and South 24 Parganas — have a high concentration of Muslims.

As the study shows, Malda is one of the most educationally backward districts in the State. Bengali Muslims about 51.27% form the majority of Malda District population whereas Bengali Hindus are the second largest community forming about 48% of District population. In literacy, Malda is far behind the State- 61.73%.
