






Capacity Building INFRASTRUCTURE SUPPORT

The Annual Status of Education Report (ASER) 2021-22 showed that 12.97 million children in the age group of 6-13 years in India were not attending school. most of these children were in rural areas.

Community Learning Project-CLC is one of our promising projects. CLCs aim at imparting basic education to the out of school children in order to make them ready for formal education and providing coaching for dropout and school going children. After providing basic literacy and education, children are enrolled in nearby schools. These centres also provide vocational training to women and adults.

CLCs are set up in slums or slum-like places having 2-3 classrooms with adequate facilities. The education and training programs in CLCs include:

CTAG is one of our promising projects which aims at providing and organizing career guidance and counseling activities and programs all over the country. The centre mainly focuses on marginalized communities in order to help them move forward in higher education and training. Different activities carried out by the center include:



WBCS Coaching Program is a promising project initiated by HWF under CTAG. The program aims at providing residential and free coaching for West Bengal Civil Service. Under the program, we started a residential coaching centre in Kolkata, West Bengal. In last two batches 19 students have qualified prelim exams and 12 students secured various government jobs. This is the first of its kind as the organization is planning to set up such centres in other underperforming districts as well.
