
IRT's mission is to strive for helping the most backward communities in the country by reducing their miseries through various empowerment and relief projects architected by expert social engineers.

### **Community Centres**

Community centres are usually used for prayer and worship but many other common purposes of community centres and positive uses. They offer a space for people to gather, socialize, and build relationships.

They also provide educational workshops and classes on topics like literacy, job skills, and health.

These centres host awareness program of Nagarik Vikas, cultural events, art exhibitions, recreational activities and performances, enriching the community's cultural life. They offer programs for youth, including after-school activities and tutoring, to keep them engaged in positive ways.

Additionally, community centres provide support services like counselling and health clinics to help people with their needs. They serve as meeting places for local groups and organizations, and in emergencies, they can act as temporary shelters for those in need.

## RAMZAN 2025 (Food Kits Distribution)



# Imam/Muazzineen Awareness & Certificate Distribution Program


Ideal Relief Trust, successfully organized a Facilitation computer certificate distribution program on 16-05-2024 for 20 trainees who completed 3 months course.
